### Introduction to Election and Enrollment Data for the 2020 redistricting cycle

The Task Force has released five spreadsheets containing election & enrollment data for 32 data sets encompassing 4 recent years (2016, 2017, 2018, 2020) at 5 geographic levels:

- State "STATEVOTE"
- County "CNTYVOTE"
- Minor Civil Division "MCDVOTE"
- Voting Tabulation District "VTDVOTE"
- Census Block "BLKVOTE"

Please see the 4 documentation pages below that provide specific information relevant to understanding the terminology used in the above data release:

- 1. Master List of Election and Enrollment Data displays the list of all years and offices for which data has been collected and dis/aggregated.
- 2. County Federal Information Processing Standards (FIPS) Codes the code numbers assigned by the Census Bureau to identify the counties within the State of New York.
- 3. Task Force Election Codes the codes used by the Task Force to identify the political offices or enrollment information contained within each column of the spreadsheets, along with an explanation of the column titles.
- 4. Party Names Election and Enrollment political party names and abbreviations.
